Auto Technology is designed around curriculum provided by the Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) society. Embedded within the curriculum are recognized National ASE Student Certifications. Students will need to achieve program benchmarks and pass the certification exam in order to receive the ASE Certification.



Students enrolled in this program may be enrolled as a dual credit college student with Ivy Tech Community College.

High School Credits:

3 credits per semester for up to 4 semesters. Credits earned will transcript as elective credits for the General, Core 40, Core 40 with Academic Honor and Core 40 with Technical Honor Diplomas.

The recommended grade level for Automotive Technology is tenth (10), eleventh (11) or twelfth (12) grade.
