

# Construction Trades



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The **Construction Trades** program at BRCP is designed for high school students who want a career in the building trades industry. In this course, students are exposed to all phases of residential construction including building or remodeling a single family home.

The skills that are learned in this program are: framing layout, framing, roofing, siding, and interior wall finishing. Students will also learn about the mechanical trades areas of electrical, plumbing, and heating and cooling systems. Additional skills acquired are: blueprint reading and material estimating.



**Construction Trades** is articulated with Ivy Tech Community College for dual credit opportunities and students can also earn 3 NCCER certifications in safety, carpentry 1, and carpentry 2. Every student will need to achieve benchmarks set by BRCP in order to receive certifications and be awarded dual credits.

**High School Credits:**

3 credits per semester for up to 4 semesters. Credits earned will qualify for the General, Core 40 with Academic Honor, and/or a Core 40 with technical Honor diplomas.

**The recommended grade level for Construction Trades is tenth (10), eleventh (11) or twelfth (12) grade.**
