Health Science Ed. II/ CNA is for students who are interested in pursuing a career as a nurse or as a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA). The course introduces students to medical terminology, safety, infection control, patient care, procedures, patient rights, ethics, professionalism and basic anatomy and physiology. The course meets at BRCP for a lecture and mock lab environment. Students will also be involved in a practicum experience in long term care facilities.

Requirements for BRCP's Health Science Ed. II program:

1. Students should complete the BRCP Health Science Education I course.
2. Students must provide their own transportation.
3. Students must complete a criminal history check.
4. Students must complete a health physical and two step tuberculosis test, and those tests must be negative.

High School Credits:



3 credits per semester for up to 2 semesters. Credits earned will qualify for the General, Core 40 with Academic Honor, and/or a Core 40 with technical Hon- or diplomas.

The recommended grade level for Health Science Ed. II is eleventh (11) or twelfth (12) grade due to the necessity of providing ones own transportation. Sophomore students may be considered.
