BRCP 2016-2017 Student Application Report

Mr. Shaw distributed a summary of the applications and names received from counselors for the 2016-2017 school year. To date, there are 394 applications or names of students who want to come to BRCP. We are working very closely with the counselors as they work with the scheduling the students. We're hoping to actually see 340 of those students in the fall.

Applications are up from Southwestern, Triton and Shelbyville. Mr. Shaw reviewed the programs and their current numbers. Four programs are currently higher than the maximum allowed, two of which are current half-day programs. Mr. Shaw will most likely recommend Auto Collision and Health Sciences I be full day programs next year. Construction Trades applications are down and may be recommended for half day program. We have received a request to offer Facility Maintenance next year. This program is based primarily on placement by Special Education teachers. Shelbyville High School has communicated their interest in starting their own Facility Maintenance program to accommodate their life skills students. Mr. Shaw noted that many of the life skills students who were in Facility Maintenance last year were placed in other programs this year since there was no offering of the Facility Maintenance program.
